


## FEELING

## MATERIALS

- 650 g balls of Lana Gatto FEELING shade \#12959 Cerulean.
- One pair size US 6 [ 4 mm ] needles or size to obtain gauge.
- Tapestry needle with rounded point.


## STITCHES

## USING KNITTING NEEDLES:

Tubular stitch [worked on even number of sts]
Row 1: K2, * wyif, slip 1 st purlwise, wyib, K1, rep from * to end. Row 2: wyif, slip 1 st purlwise, * K1, wyif, slip 1 st purlwise, wyib, rep from * to last st, K1. Rep these 2 rows.
1x1 Rib [worked on even number of sts]
Row 1 [RS]: * K1, P1; rep from * to end.
Row 2: $K$ the knit sts and $P$ the purl sts.
Rep Row 2 throughout for 1x1 Rib.
Mock Fisherman's Rib [worked over a multiple of 4 sts]
Row 1 [RS]: * K3, P1; rep from * to end.
Row 2 [WS]: * K2, P1, K1; rep from * to end.
Rep these 2 rows throughout for Mock Fisherman's Rib.

USING TAPESTRY NEEDLE:

## Darning stitch

## GAUGE

25 sts and 34 rows to $4 \mathrm{in} / 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ over Mock Fisherman's Rib lightly stretched using size US 6 [ 4 mm ] needles.

## ABBREVIATIONS

| cm | centimeters | rep | repeat |
| :--- | :--- | :--- | :--- |
| g | grams | RS | right side[s] |
| in | inch[es] | st[s] | stitch[es] |
| k | knit | WS | wrong side[s] |
| mm | milimeters | wyib | with yarn in back |
| p | purl | wyif | with yarn in front |

## BACK \& FRONT [MAKE 2 PIECES ALIKE]

With size US 6 [4mm] needles, cast on 180 sts. Work 4 rows in Tubular st and 2 rows in $1 \times 1$ Rib for lower edge. Then work in Mock Fisherman's Rib decreasing 1 st at each end on next and every following 4th row until 120 sts remain [approximately $14 \mathrm{in} / 35 \mathrm{~cm}$ from lower edge.]
Next row [RS]: * K3 tog, P1; rep from * to end.
Work 25 rows in $1 \times 1$ Rib and 6 rows in Tubular st, for cowl. Bind off in Darning st with a tapestry needle.

## FINISHING

Sew side seams
