

LITTLE CHANEL JACKET



Size: 10/12 (14/16) UK **Size:** 6/8 (10/12) USA **Size:** 36/38 (40/42) EU

NOTE: Figures in brackets () refer to larger size. Where

only one figure is given this refers to both sizes.

Skill Level: intermediate

How much yarn: g 250 (300) of Bellevue yarn no. 8839 **Needles:** Two double-pointed (Dp) 4.50 mm (no. 7)

Pair of 4.50 mm (no. 7) knitting needles

Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

STITCHES

Using needles: Tubular stitch - Stocking stitch (st st)

TENSION

14 sts and 20 rows measure 10 cm square over st st with 4.50 mm (no. 7) needles.

INSTRUCTIONS

Back: with 4.50 mm (no. 7) needles cast on 72 (80) sts. Work 4 rows in tubular st. Then work in st st. When work measures 34 (37) cm from beg, shape armholes: cast off 2 sts at beg of next 6 (8) rows: 60 (64) sts remain. When armholes measure 18 (20) cm, shape shoulders. Cast off 7 sts at beg of next 2 rows and 7 (8) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Cast off rem 32 (34) sts, for neckedge.

Right front: with 4.50 mm (no. 7) needles cast on 36 (40) sts. Work 4 rows in tubular st. Then work in st st. When work measures 34 (37) cm from beg, shape armhole on LH (left hand) side as Back: 30 (32) sts remain. When armhole measures 12 (13) cm, shape neck. On RH (right hand) side (beg of row, on RS of work) cast off first 6 (7) sts, work 1 row, (cast off first 2 sts, work 1 row) 5 times. When armhole measure 18 (20) cm, ending with a RS row, shape right shoulder

on LH side (beg of row, on WS of work). Cast off 7 sts, work 1 row, then cast off rem 7 (8) sts.

Left front: work as Right Front reversing shapings.

Sleeves: with 4.50 mm (no. 7) needles, cast on 44 (49) sts. Work 4 rows in tubular st. Then work in st st. Inc 1 st at each end every 8th row 4 (5) times. There are 52 (59) sts. When sleeve measures 28 (31) cm from beg, cast off 2 sts at beg of next 4 rows, then dec 1 st at each end every alternate row 6 (8) times, then cast off 2 sts at beg of next 10 rows. Cast off rem 12 (15) sts.

Neck and front opening border: with 4.50 mm (no. 7) Dp needles cast on 4 sts. Make an I-cord as follows: K4, * do not turn work but slide sts to opposite end of needle and pull yarn tightly across back of sts, K4. Rep from * until cord measures as required. Cast off.

FINISHING

With yarn needle, sew shoulder and side seams. Sew sleeve seams, then set in sleeves. Join Border starting from lower edge of a Front opening; cont around neckedge and down opening of other Front, ending at lower edge.
